ADMINISTRATION REPORT

The Director of Administration's role includes supervising the office, registrations and the preparation of the Annual Report, calling and documenting monthly board meetings and the AGM, and finally ensuring that the club house is kept well maintained.

As gear has often been borrowed from the club for legitimate purposes and yet there has been no record of who borrowed it and who approved the loan, this year, we have established a loan register with the assistance of Mick van Dartel. Anyone who needs to take club gear away from Terrigal Club or beach is asked to get approval from Mick, Beris Meldrum, the Club Director of Administration or the Club President and to fill out the loan registry which is held in the tower room.

During the year, the club has purchased and installed a Point of Sale (POS) system for recording all bar sales from the club. It is hoped that over time it will be extended for the sale of club clothing and merchandise. The POS system both enables the club to keep a closer track of monies and stock.

The main work done on the club house this year has been:

- replacement of a number of the doors, door locks and handles
- tinting of the Northern windows of the club house
- installation of a new radio microphone system for the upstairs function room

The club has been in the process of upgrading the club website so that it becomes the central source of information for both lifesaving and competition.

Not strictly the role of the Director of Administration, but this year Debi Barnes and myself ran the annual Terrigal Ocean Swim. This year we decided to hold it on Easter Saturday to encourage participation from holiday makers and swimmers from Sydney. It was very successful with over 270 swimmers compared to only 190 the previous year. From sponsorship, entries, merchandise and BBQ it raised nearly \$9000 for the club. Due to the success of this date we intend on making it a regular Easter Saturday event.

LIFESAVING REPORT

This season we had over 300 active patrolling members made up into 16 patrols including an Active Reserve patrol.

Congratulations to all patrol captains and patrols having no lives lost once again between the flags, over 1,100 preventative actions and only 21 rescues. This is a very good indication of pro active patrolling from all patrols. Terrigal is a very busy beach with thousands of beachgoers spreading right along the beach from the rock pool to the Terrigal Lagoon creating quite a deal of planning for the captain and team work amongst the patrol.

The patrols gained 32 new bronze medallion members this season and many of our patrolling members also upskilled their qualifications with 39 attaining their Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate, 10 attaining IRB crew and 12 their Silver Medallion IRB Drivers giving us a very good spread of skills in all patrols. Thanks must go to the education team who worked tirelessly throughout the season to teach these awards.

We continue to have lots of nippers coming through the rookie program with 32 gaining their Surf Rescue Certificate this season and learning to be part of a patrol team with lots of patrol activities and fun.

Thanks must go to Roger Stimson for his continued responsibility for the IRBs and motors, quite a job to keep them all in good working order and available for patrols. Thanks also to Matt Robinson and Toni Jones for their commitment to keeping the first aid room well stocked, clean and tidy, a not inconsiderable job with the number of people using the room. Peter Connelly took on the radios this year and has done a wonderful job of making sure they are all charged up and in good working order. Graham Baty has been ensuring the jetski helmet and radio are all charged and available for all RWC drivers using the RWC out of the Terrigal shed, well done.

Thanks to all for your commitment to your patrols, the club and the beach going public.

JUNIOR ACTIVITIES

It is pleasing to report another successful year for Terrigal Nippers in all areas of junior activities, being education, surf lifesaving, competition, fund raising and community involvement. Importantly as a volunteer based organisation nippers would not be possible without the assistance of parents, grandparents and members in many roles including Age Mangers (and assistants), Water Safety, Officials, Education, First Aid, Recording, Carnival Entries, Clothing, BBQ Duty, IRB, Rookies, Coaching, plus much more. To all those that have assisted this year thank you. In particular I acknowledge the contribution of the JAC Executive, Craig Pollington (Nippers), Wes Pettiford (Deputy) and Kevin Porter (Finance) and our Club Secretary Beris Meldrum for their efforts and commitment.

In 2013/14 Terrigal had 255 nippers registered with an average attendance of 195. Importantly 90% of all nippers completed their education proficiencies.

At the beginning of the season the JAC looked at how we could improve and assist in the development of our nippers. New initiatives introduced include an Iron person pre-season squad for the 11- 13 conducted by Jack Moyes. A four week introduction to surf and board conducted for the 9's and beginners at Des Johns Swim Centre as well pre season competencies and an introduction day for new nippers. In addition beginners' board sessions were scheduled each Saturday morning to assist in nippers gaining greater confidence in the water.

Our regular nippers Sundays, provided a mix of skills and fun sessions underpinned by surf education combined with the popular Rescue Day and the Australia Day weekend twilight nippers and *Little's* Disco, as well as our Club Championship Rounds. Every age group was required to assist twice per season in BBQ and beach set up to ensure the smooth running of our nippers' days.

The Rookie program seen our older nippers step up and actively fundraise and be involved community activities, as well as undertake patrols for the first time.

The Sunday BBQ and proceeds from hosting the second junior SLSCC junior carnival were the main source of revenue for nippers offsetting the presentation night costs, the purchase and upkeep of junior equipment as well as the acquisition of additional items such as the mini marquees for carnivals.

In competition Terrigal competed in four local carnivals and State Age Championship at Umina where we were placed 10th, as well as successfully competing in events at Forster, Newcastle Permanent Junior Ironperson Series, Manly Nipper Nationals, and Bennett, Kracka and Gardner Iron person, Interbranch, Cooks Hill Classic and the Australian Pool Rescue Championships.

Importantly whilst Terrigal does have individual champions, it has been in team events where the club has excelled. Our thanks again, to all our coaches who have worked to develop the skills of our nippers throughout the season.

LIFE MEMBERS REPORT

The financial report has disclosed that the Life Members Fund enjoys a credit balance of \$59,051.21 (Fifty nine thousand and fifty one dollars 21¢). These funds are held at National Australia Bank A/c # 53878-3225 (\$530.30) and Term Deposit #12-236-0215 (\$58,520.91). This Term Deposit is due to mature on 29th August, 2014. The deposit and interest due of \$2,304.84 will be rolled over for a further term.

The Life Members fund has seen an increase of \$848.19 over the past year. This amount was solely due to interest received on the term deposit. This amount was equal to only 4 months of interest at 4.4%. The term deposit was then rolled over on 29th August, 2013 for a further term of 12 months at 4.00% and is due to mature on 29th August, 2014. A total of \$2,340.84 will be added to the deposit on this date.

No fund raising was conducted during the year due to the absence of the writer. However a Melbourne Cup function has been booked in for the coming year. Together with the interest due and proceeds from this function, it is hoped in excess of \$5/6.000 will increase the balance of the fund.

Donations to the Surf Club have exceeded in excess of \$14,000 since the Fund was established in 1983. The vision for the establishment of the Fund was to create a "Future Fund" for the enhancement of the Club's growth in the ensuring years. The fund is not there for the utilization by any committee or committees. The Fund is fully run by the Life Members and is conducted on a perpetual basis.

Below is a short summary of the history of the Life Members Fund –

- Foundation of the Life Members Fund during 1983. Foundation members were Life Member Mark Power and Life Member Peter Wyllie.
- Fund established for future members to receive the benefit of the past and present members of the Club.
- Fund to be conducted on a perpetual basis and continue to remain this way.
- Core assets to be retained to ensure the future of the Trust.
- An amount of up to 80% of the interest earned to be donated to the Club at the discretion of the trustees on an annual basis. Thus a minimum amount of the remaining 20% of interest income will be retained to ensure future growth of the Fund.
- The Fund will not intentionally impede on the Club's fund raising efforts and all funds raised in the name of the Fund to be retained by the Fund.
- Life Member Jack Tennent made a donation from his estate in 1989-1990 season of the sum of \$1,000.
- First objective target of the Fund was \$10,000 and this was achieved in the 1992/1993 season.
- Funds in excess of \$14,000 have been donated to the Club since the Fund was established in 1983. This amount has been made up of direct cash donations and the value of the jackets which are presented on the Awards of Excellence Night.
- The vision for this Fund is that in the future the Fund will be able to provide one or more scholarships/sponsorships for the members of the Club on an annual basis. These awards will take the form of educational funding or direct sporting cost funding. This, however, will not occur until the Fund achieves sufficient capital to make this possible.

The Trustees have received several enquiries with regard to legacies to the Fund. A Trust Deed is in the process of being prepared to meet the wishes of these donors.

Through the fund all donations are making a serious investment towards the training and resourcing of our volunteer lifesavers. Legacy gifts will ensure that the next generation of up and coming lifesavers will be prepared to take on critical lifesaving tasks in the future.

The Life Members are happy to answer any enquiries on the principal function and direction of the Fund at any time.

We will also be grateful for any meaningful input on future fund raising opportunities or direct contribution to the Fund.

The present Trustees of the Life Members Fund are Mark Power, David Mansfield and Ron Stone.

On 4th May, 2014 the Life Members held a meeting and conducted an election for the 2014-2015 season. Life Members Mark Power, David Mansfield and Ron Stone were re-elected for a further term. These Life Members names will be forwarded for ratification at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting.

AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF TERRIGAL SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB INC.

NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW). The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

(a) Plant & Equipment Depreciation

Plant and equipment are recorded at cost and are depreciated on a straight line basis over their estimated useful lives.

The depreciation rates used for each class of assets are:

Building improvements: 4% to 20% Surf equipment: 33% Function room plant & fittings 20%

Office equipment: 20%

Plant and equipment which has an estimated useful life of one year or less have been expensed at purchase and are shown as gear purchases in the Club's profit and loss account.

(b) GST Units

Under the provisions of GST legislation relating to non-profit bodies, the Club has established independent accounting units for its separate functions with differing GST treatments.

The accounts of each of these independent units have been amalgamated in the preparation of the Club's accounts.

(c) Income Tax

The Club is exempt from income tax and accordingly no liability is recorded.

(d) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost or net realisable value.

(e) Leases

Leases of fixed assets, where substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to the ownership of the asset, but not the legal ownership, are transferred to the Club, are classified as finance leases. Finance leases are capitalised recording an asset and a liability equal to the present value of the minimum lease payments, including any



guaranteed residual values. Leased assets are amortised on a straight line basis over their estimated useful lives where it is likely that the Club will obtain ownership of the asset or over the term of the lease. Lease payments are allocated between the reduction of the lease liability and the lease interest expense for the period.

Lease payments under operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the period in which they are incurred.

(f) Revenue

Revenue is recognised as follows:

- Members income, donations and sponsorship revenue is recognised on receipt and recording in the books of the Surf Club.
- Income from the sale of merchandise and product from the canteen is recognised when the merchandise or product from the canteen is supplied to the customer.
- Income from hire of the club house (hall hire) is recognised at the time the club house is provided to the customer.
