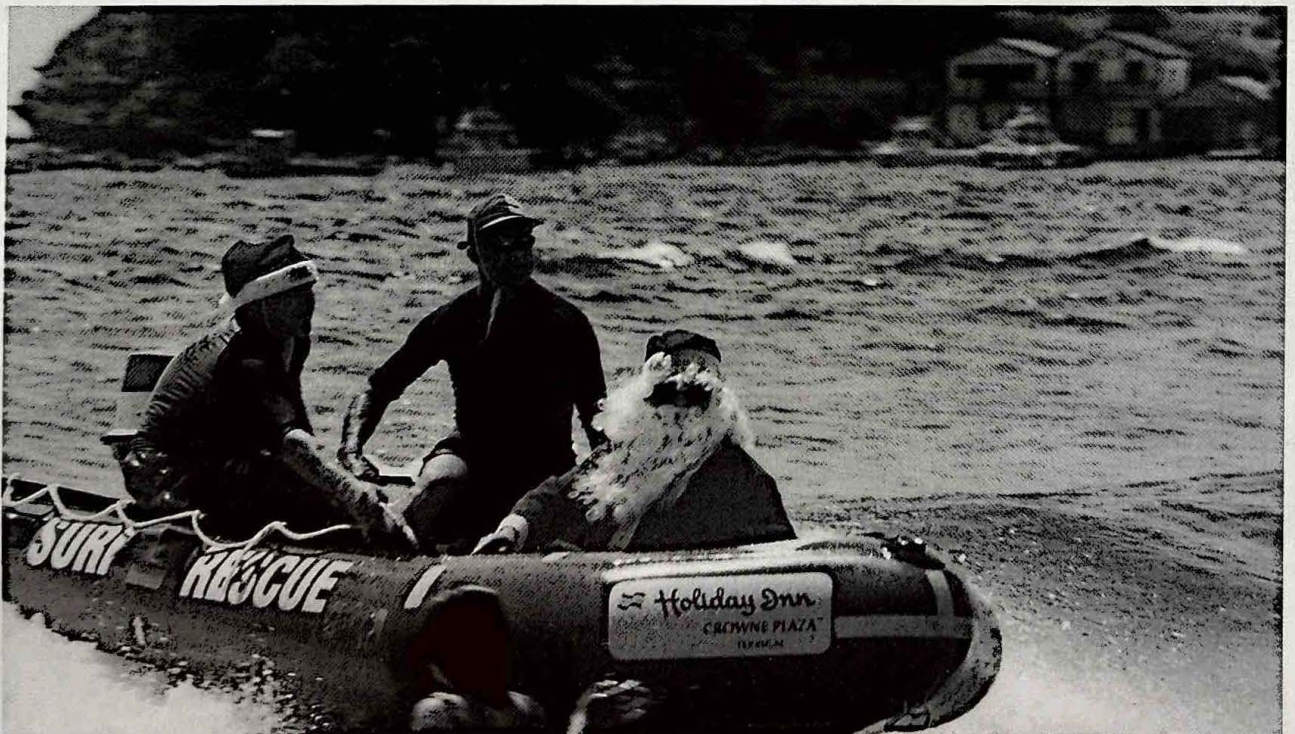

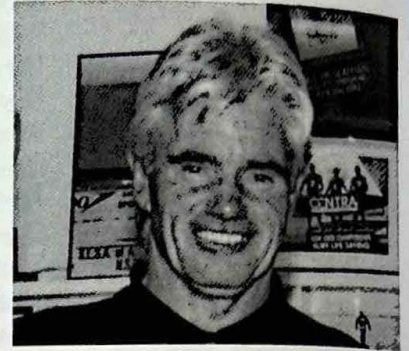

Jack Ward joined the Terrigal Surf Life Saving Club Inc. during the 1985/86 season as an active member. He had previously been a member of the Wanda Surf Club where he had gained his bronze medallion.

From his first year, when he was named Rookie of the Year, he was devoted to the Club and over the years he held many positions on the Management Committee and gained awards for outstanding service on two occasions.

He was a member of the Central Coast Board of Examiners and at the time of his death was the District Supervisor of Number 5 District, a position he held for many years.

Jack's significant contribution was recognised by the Club in 1995 when he was elevated to life membership, the Club's highest award.

Raised in the Sydney suburb of Newtown Jack was actively involved in rugby league and represented the Newtown Rugby Leagues Club as a cheeky halfback. He joined the Royal Australian navy and saw active duty in Vietnam for which, in later life, he was granted a war pension.

On discharge from the Navy he moved to Nyngan where he managed the local swimming pool. Through this job he became involved in the Royal Life Saving Society and was an examiner with that organisation until his death. He

moved to Sydney and became involved with handicapped children and supervised their activities in the therapy pool at a children's spastic centre.

He maintained his devotion to the handicapped when he moved to the Central Coast where he worked as a supervisor with the "Crew Cuts". This organisation provided work for intellectually handicapped young people to help them to supplement their pension by cutting lawns around the community.

In addition, to his deep commitment to the surf life saving movement, Jack also maintained his interest in rugby league and during the winter months was a trainer with a local club.

Jack Ward was a great worker for his community and this was recognised by the many organisations that were represented at his funeral.

Jack is survived by wife Gwen and daughters Sharon and Allison. Jack will be deeply missed and all members of the Club wish to convey to Gwen, Sharon and Allison their deepest sympathy.

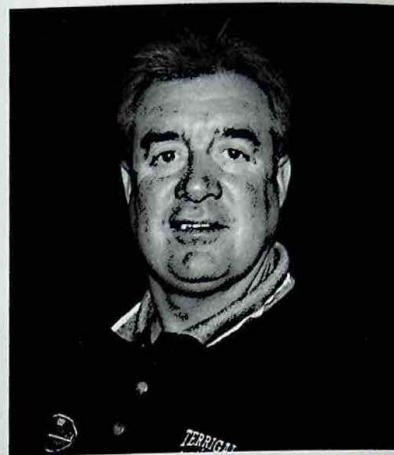

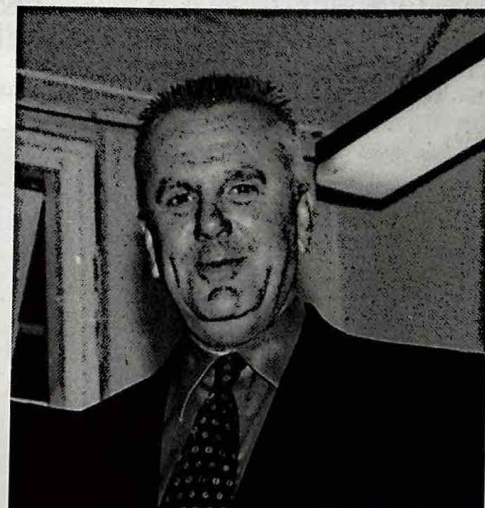

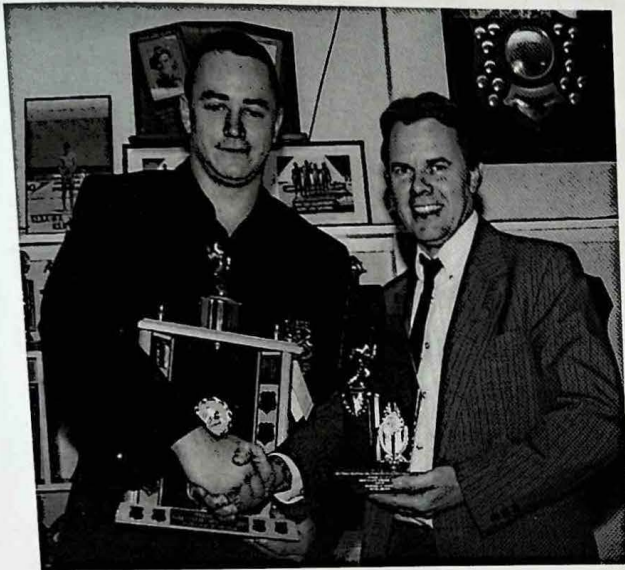

Chief Instructor's Report

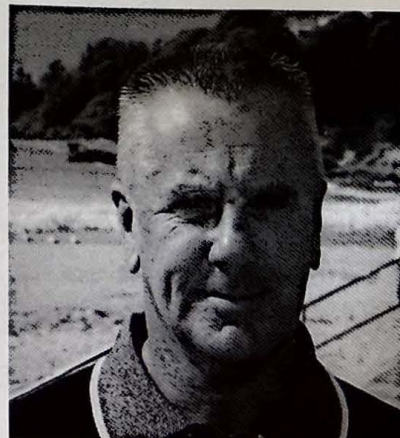

FIRST AID OFFICER'S REPORT

The First Aid room is the hub of the club and this season has been busy as usual. The majority of first aid has involved the treatment of marine stings and unlike last year we were fortunate not to have so many minor first aid cases of embedded splinters of glass caused from broken glass bottles on the foreshore. The patrols have all managed and dealt with first aid situations with competence and care. A reminder to all members attending First Aid to wear gloves comes at a time when Hepatitis B&C still continues to prevail.

Vaccination against Hepatitis B is available at Terrigal Medial Centre and Dr. Keith Evershed our Hon. Medical Officer can arrange this and strongly urges all patrol members to be fully vaccinated. 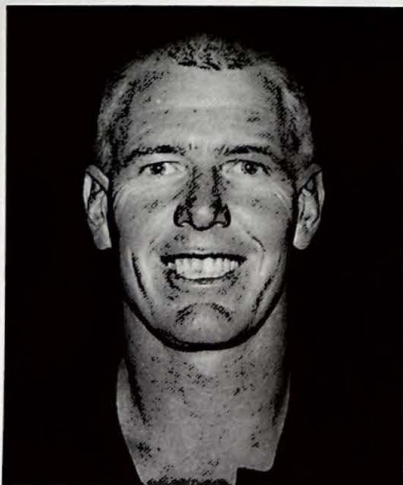


RADIO OFFICER'S REPORT

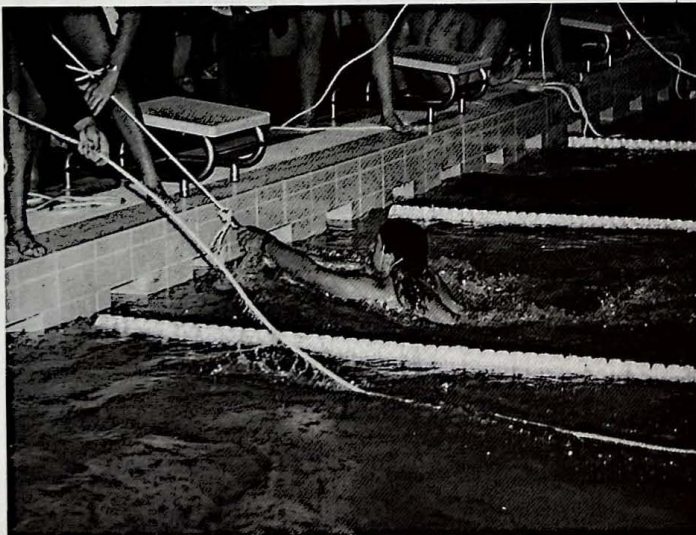
COMPETITION REPORT

In the Peters Boat Series, the reserve boat crew finished second overall (after having points deducted from one round) and the vets boat crew finished 4th overall.

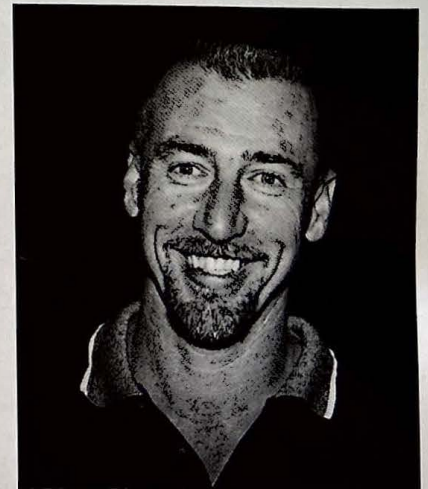

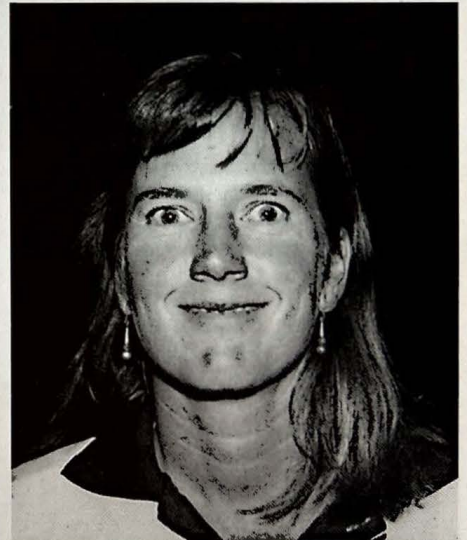
ROOKIE CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT
