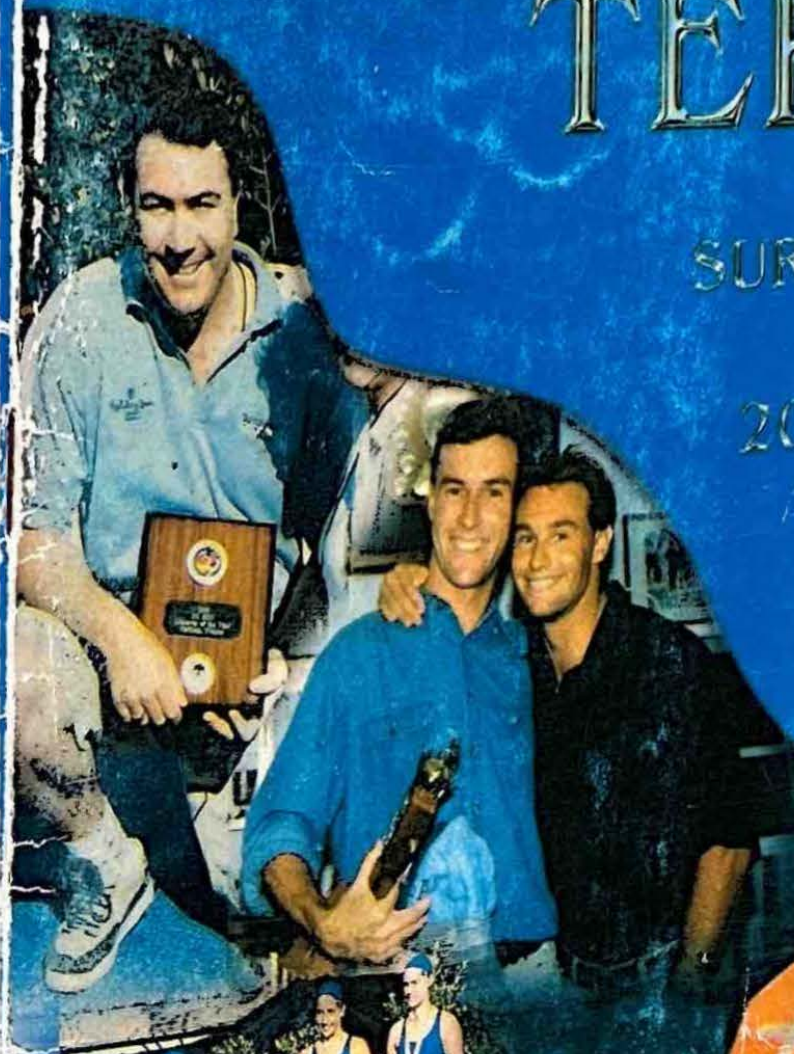


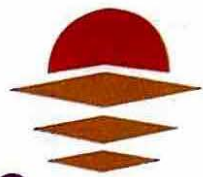

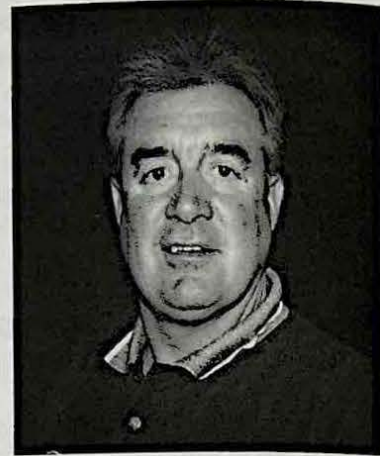

We have had a great season this year. Despite the work being done on the new sea wall, all patrols handled the disruption extremely professionally and I wish to extend my sincere thanks to all patrol members, especially patrol captain's and patrol vice captain's for offering an excellent rescue service whilst the wall was being built.

Once again we have retained our reputation of keeping Terrigal as one of the Central Coast's safest beaches with no lives lost in the patrol area again. This is something that has been hard to obtain and we must remind ourselves that it can be easily lost, so we must remain even more vigilant next season.

The patrols have been tested this season with a number of major rescues and incidents at Terrigal, but the patrols have handled these with ease. Although our rescue statistics are down from last season, this can be attributed to a number of reasons, being;

- Reduced patronage of the beach during the building of the sea wall.
- Changed beach conditions.
- Increased active membership
- Earlier intervention through Preventative Actions.
- Higher training standards of our Patrol Captain's and Patrol Vice Captain's

With the position of Chief Instructor not being filled this year, I took on this role and as a result 3 bronze squads and an IRB squad were put through. In addition Paul Quick completed a bronze squad, Beris Meldrum completed an Advanced Resuscitation Certificate squad and Cathy Cole worked tirelessly with the juniors completing their training with the Surf Rescue Certificate. It was a great team effort and I know the club appreciates all this work.

Personally, I would like to thank Greg Elfick for all the hard work he has done this year in assisting me whilst I have had the additional roles this season. Without his assistance a lot of programs would never have been completed this year.

As most of our members know, I have had a gratifying season and it was an extreme pleasure to represent the club and myself in the Lifesaver of the Year Awards. IRB CAPTAINS REPORT

The 1999/2000 season has been a busy one for all aspects of IRB operations within the Club. The first, and most important, function of IRB's is to be reliably present on the beach for each patrol as a means of performing rescues as needed. The purchase of new prop guards has seen the introduction of two new Johnson motors into service to add to those already being used on patrol. This has greatly increased the reliability of the equipment being used and also reduced the wear and tear on individual motors throughout the season. Apart from the inevitable minor repairs that are expected during the year, no major problems were experienced. This saw an effective IRB on the beach for patrol and reliable back-up equipment if needed. In order to maintain both the boats and motors in this way takes the co-operation of all. I would like to thank individual patrol captains for their efforts in ensuring that equipment has been properly cleaned and stored and reporting problems that have arisen. This goes a long way towards ensuring that the effective serviceable condition and avoiding costly repairs.

The current season has also proven to be both a successful

one for the Club's competitive IRB team. The purchase of a new soft-bottom Achilles hull and Tohatsu motor has allowed Terrigal to compete on an even footing with other Clubs. This, along with many hours of team training, has seen the current season to be an increasing successful one for all those involved. At the time of writing, many of the major carnivals for IRB's still lay ahead with team looking forward to a continuation of good form and competitiveness they have shown in competitions to date. Terrigal's IRB teams (the Turtles) have taken part in a number of carnivals this season with the "away" trips providing some great opportunities for competition and a few "good nights out" to go with it. With Terrigal's team predominantly consisting of those fitting into the Masters category, the opportunity to unwind with a few drinks after a hard day in the water, can never be overlooked, and is an important part of the touring itinerary.

The first of the major competitions for the year was that of the World Championship held at Manly in March. All events were contested in the 'Open' category. Terrigal crews performed exceptionally well. A highlight of the carnival was the team's finish in the tube rescue. With 169 teams starting the event, Terrigal finished in the top 30, missing the next round by one placing.

A big thanks you to Cathy Thomas who has been our manager throughout the season.

The current season has seen new IRB awards issued to Nathan and Darren Jameson. Hopefully there will be more members obtaining their IRB award next season and we will see more drivers & crew joining the IRB competition training squad.
