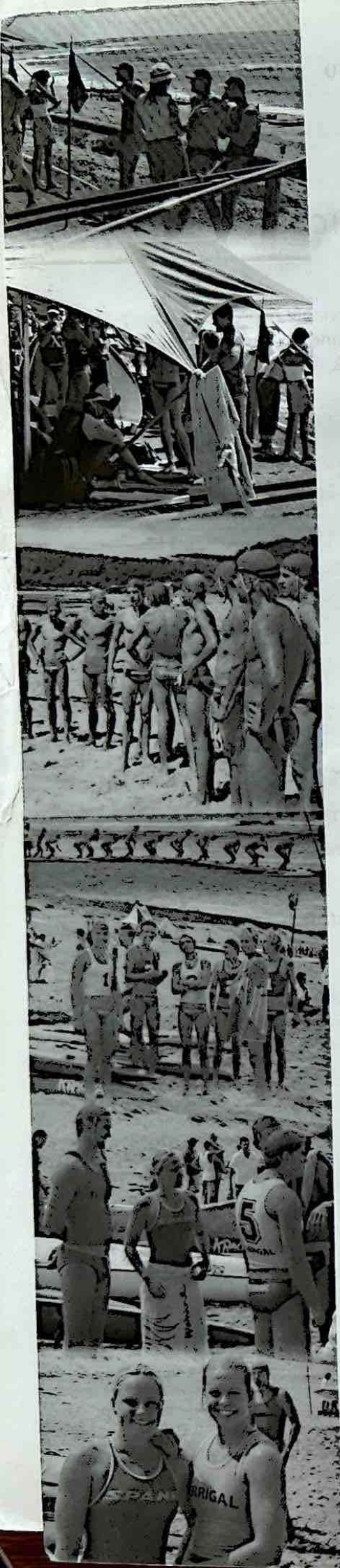
Persons standing for the positions **MUST BE FINANCIAL** at the time of nomination.

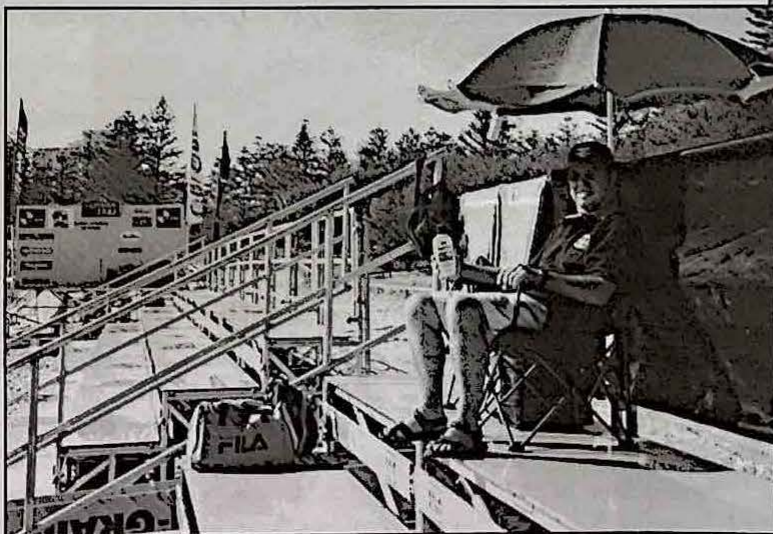

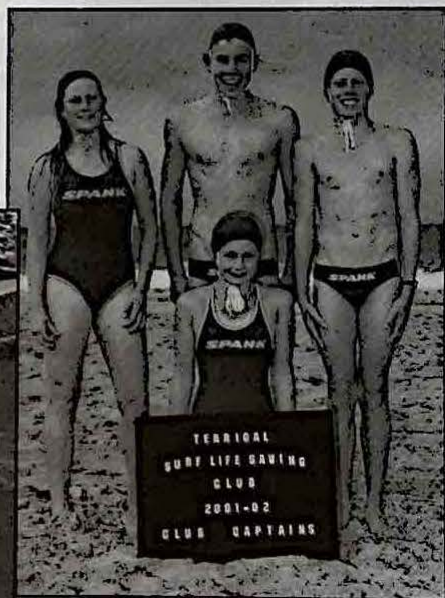

## CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT

There is an old Chinese saying "may you live in interesting times". This has certainly been the case for The Terrigal Surf Lifesaving Club recently. Moving into the new facilities this season has involved changes to patrol procedures, equipment housing, and coping with all of the incidental items that arrived with it. Essentially it has been a season of rebuilding and realignment. Fortunately the conditions have been kind to us. Generally calmer weather has seen reduced rescues and first aid cases, even though attendance at the beach is 30% up on the previous season – partly a flow on from the Olympics.

Terrigal patrol members should congratulate themselves. Once again a season has completed without a life being lost on our beach while we were on patrol. Although our beach is regarded as a safer beach, this generally means that visitors tend to take more risks when swimming. Many times a patrol may see swimmers well away from the flags, or a long way out into the bay. A person in distress could occur just about anywhere. Much of the success of our patrols has been due to the vigilance of our members. The result is a simple retrieval, and the rescued is no worse for their experience.

This requirement has been further highlighted, by two drowning incidents on the Central Coast this season. Tower observation has been re-introduced as a necessity. The old Club-house had a tower, difficult to access. The new tower has excellent view and access.

### PATROL CAPTAINS AND VICE CAPTAINS

It takes special people to become Patrol Captains and Vice-Captains. These people put in hours of effort, being early for patrols, ensuring the patrols are operating properly, and closing up afterwards. Many thanks to new Patrol Captains and Vice-Captains.

### WESTFIELD ROOKIES

We have had a large number of Rookies on our patrols this season (more than 60). This is a testament to the strength of our juniors membership, and the enthusiasm of these people. The Rookies are a valued and appreciated part of our patrols and I would like to thank them for their attendance and efforts over the season. Terrigal rookies won the Westfield Rookie Challenge this year, and used the proceedings to donate a Whiteboard and Noticeboard for the use of the Patrols and Rookies. These have been installed in the patrol equipment room, and many thanks for their donation.

### AWARDS

Our Patrols have been greatly strengthened by people completing higher awards such as the Silver Medallion Patrol Captain, First Aid certificates, Silver Medallion IRB Drivers awards. Some people have even become qualified to use the defibrillator, which has now become part of the lifesaving equipment at our club. This has greatly increased the ability of our patrols.

### IRB USAGE

As previously mentioned, patrols have been strengthened by the addition of many new IRB drivers. The Gosford City Council water safety levy provided money for some new safety signs for the club, and also a new IRB motor. With our existing patrol IRB within 18 months of the end of its useful life, the question needs to be asked, where to proceed from here. On another note, IRB competitions temporarily suspended due to litigation concerns, should be back in operation by Christmas 2002.





**PATROL PROFICIENCY AWARD**

Recipients of this award have shown a high dedication to their patrol work throughout the season and are to be commended. Such results are difficult to achieve given the pressures on time that exist from day to day. These people completed all their scheduled patrols, or obtained a substitute, and patrolled all of the required hours.

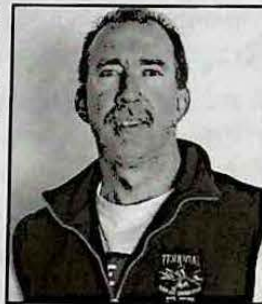


**ROOKIE OF THE YEAR**

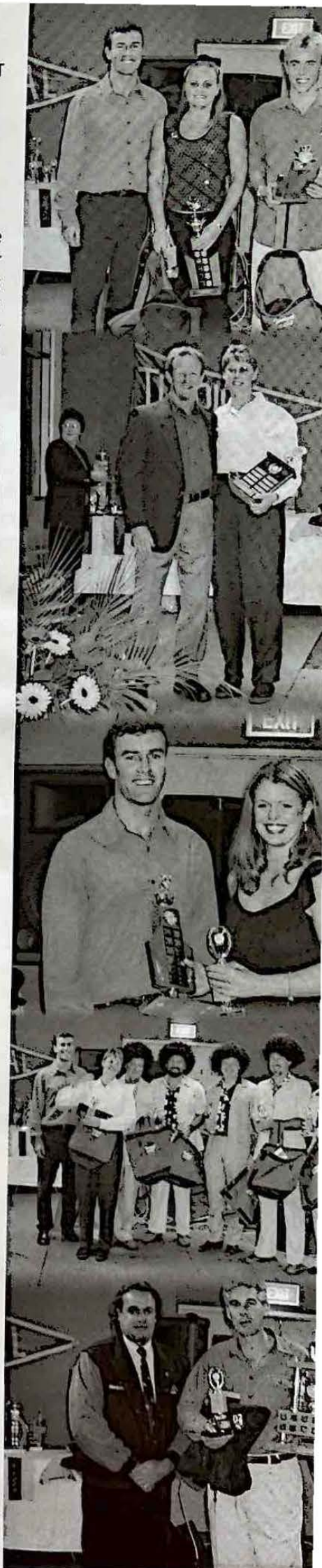
**ASSOCIATE OF THE YEAR**

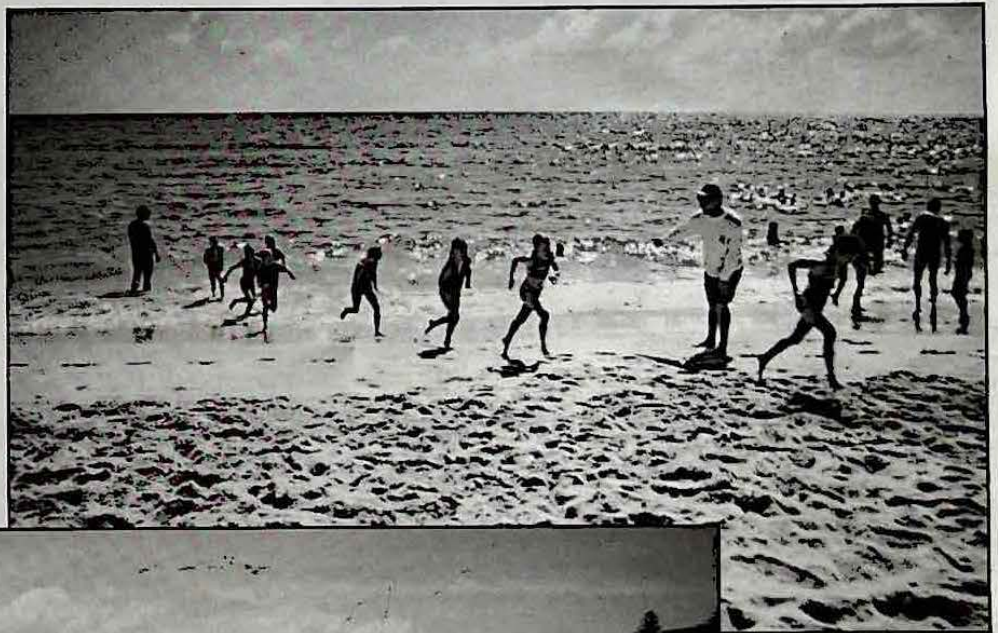

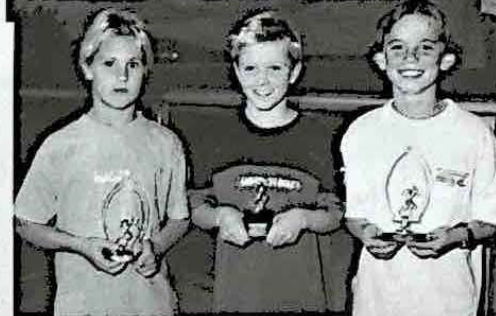

## LIFE MEMBER'S REPORT

The financial report has disclosed the Life Member's Fund enjoys a credit balance of \$6,170-62 with a loan to the Senior Club of \$9,000 outstanding. Total assets of the Fund are \$15,170-62

This is an improvement from last years result of \$14,016-24. The income was \$154-38 from interest and \$1,000 donation from Heather and Mark Power from sale of photographs taken by Heather.

The Fund granted a Loan of \$12,000 to the Senior Club to assist with the purchase of chairs and tables for the new club house. To date the Club has repaid \$3,000 of this loan with \$9,000 plus interest still outstanding. This was to be repaid at \$1,000 per month with the first repayment at the end of December 2001. As at date of this report the Club is \$2,000 in arrears with repayments. These arrears will be taken up with the Club Management Committee.

The Fund has been unable to make a donation to the Club during the last year due to the loan which was made available to them. The Club, however, is to make an interest payment to the Fund to ensure the future growth of the Fund.

It is hopeful that the Life Members will be able to undertake further fund raising during the coming twelve months which will ensure growth of the fund and assistance to the club in the future.

To date the Life Members Fund has donated in excess of \$3,100 to the Club.

The present trustees of the Life Members Fund are Paul Hawkins, Ron Stone and Mark Power.

## NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING POLICIES

## 1. Accruals Basis

The Financial Statements have been prepared under the accruals basis of accounting.

## 2. Revenue and Expense Recognition

The TERRIGAL SURF LIFESAVING CLUB INC. is a non-profit organisation and receives most of its income from donations and specific fundraising events. Amounts by their nature can only be recognised when they are recorded in the books of the Club.

## 3. Plant &amp; Equipment Depreciation

Plant and equipment are recorded at cost and are depreciated over their estimated useful lives using the reducing balance method.

## 4. GST Units

Under the provisions of GST legislation relating to non-profit bodies, the Club has established independent accounting units for its separate functions with differing GST treatments.

The accounts of each of these independent units have been amalgamated in the preparation of the Club's accounts.

The Club is covered for all public liability claims under the public liability policy established by the NSW Surf Lifesaving Association. Policies covering damage to or theft of property and workers compensation have also been taken out directly by the Club. Accordingly the Committee believes that its insurance coverage is adequate to cover contingencies in these instances.

**Loan Commitments****(a) Gosford City Council (Unsecured)**

During the year the Club entered into arrangements with the Gosford City Council regarding the financing of the shortfall in the Council's budget for the fittings of the new clubhouse and for the installation of the clubhouse air conditioning system.

Under these arrangements the Club was committed to repayments of \$2,500 per month for nine years and four months.

The Council has since indicated that this arrangement is to be amended, and the repayments incorporated in the clubhouse lease arrangements, which are yet to be finalised.

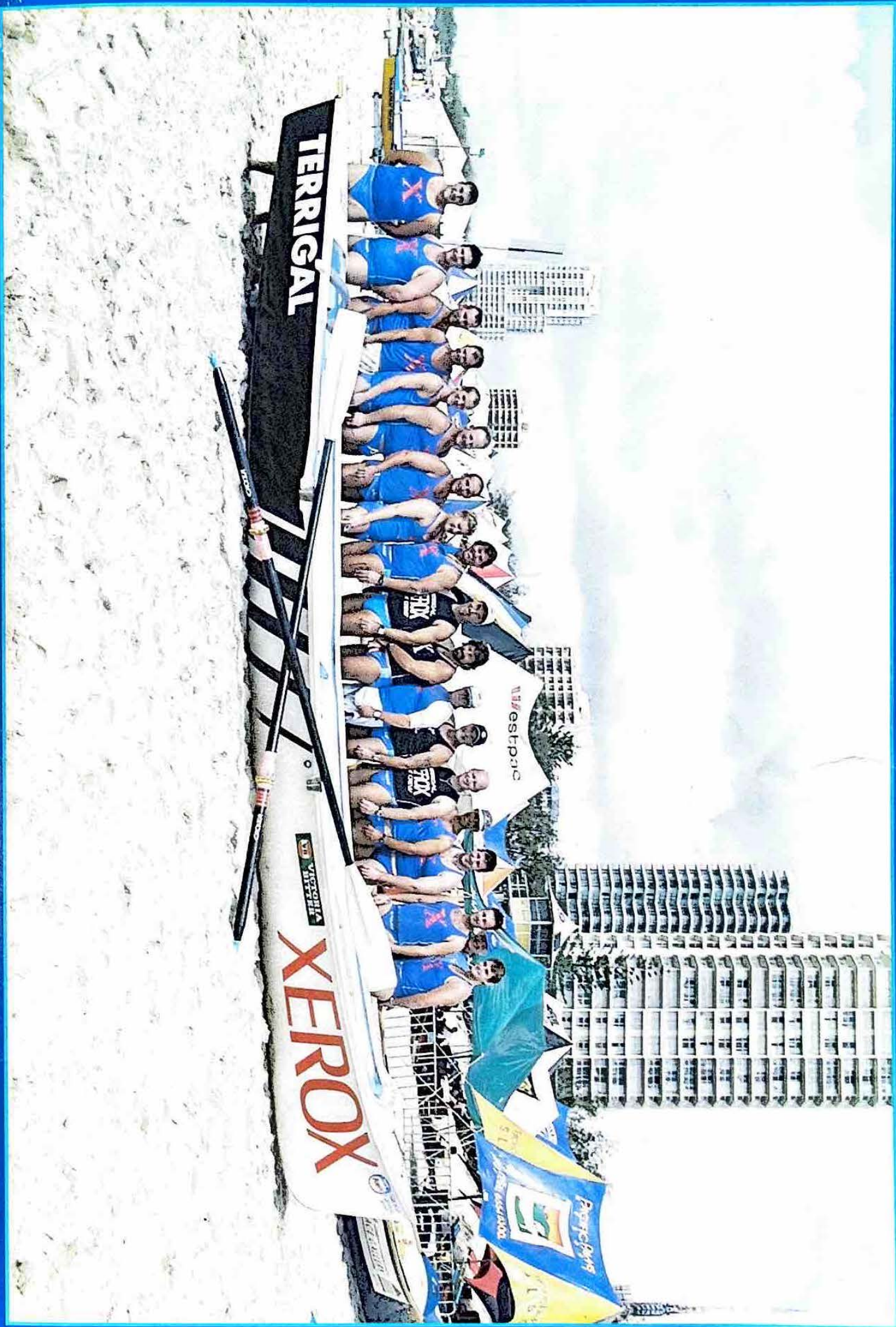
In the meantime, the Treasurer has deposited the monthly repayment amount to a term deposit account in the Club's name as a provision against a future request from the Council for repayment as originally arranged.

**(b) Life Members Fund (Unsecured)**

During the year the Club borrowed an amount of \$12,000 from the Life Members Fund, of which \$9,000 was outstanding at year-end.

The remainder of the loan is repayable within the next twelve months, together with interest of \$1,000.
